Skyward Credit Union teamed up with the listeners of KMWU, Wichita's public radio station, to present a check for \$5,000 to the Guadalupe Clinic. For every pledge made during KMWU's Spring Pledge Drive, Skyward agreed to cover the cost of a medical visit to Guadalupe Clinic for someone in need.

Guadalupe Clinic is a donation-based safety-net clinic that provides health care to residents of Sedgwick County. They see patients whom are working but cannot afford other health care options. For a \$5 donation, patients receive doctor's care, lab tests, X-rays, and medications. Over 300 Medical Volunteers donate their time annually to serve thousands of patients.



Safely Dispose of Personal Information

Before you dispose of a computer, get rid of all the personal information it stores. Use a wipe utility program to overwrite the entire hard drive.

Before you dispose of a mobile device, check your owner's manual, the service provider's website, or the device manufacturer's website for information on how to delete information permanently, and how to save or transfer information to a new device. Remove the memory or subscriber identity module (SIM) card from a mobile device. Remove the phone book, lists of calls made and received, voicemails, messages sent and received, organizer folders, web search history, and photos.
